



BE A SERVANT

Jesus often reminded his disciples that to be a leader meant that you must be a servant. In this position, we serve the church by creating an environment for kids to learn about Jesus. It's important as a church that we create worship environments for all walks of life to serve Him.

BE CARING

God has called us as His children to care for each other, to bear each other's burdens, and to encourage one another. How we care for each other is a testimony to the world of how Jesus cares for us. We need to make sure that we are accessible to people, that we pray for others, and that we serve from a place of compassion and responsibility.

BE AVAILABLE

Whether its apparent or not, the kids see you as a leader! When we are available to the youth, it can have a huge impact on how kids engage in worship environments.

Seek to be available to the kids as much as possible when they need guidance in their walk with Christ.

ASPIRE TO GROW AS A LEADER

Excellence is simply doing the best you can with what you have. However, with more experience and more opportunity our excellence should be ever increasing. We want you to grow as a leader. Therefore we ask that you are open to evaluation, and are willing to grow in your teaching. We also want you to grow spiritually. Therefore we want to help you in your pursuit to live a holy life. Attending church, praying, exploring God's Word, and serving in this way all help us to grow to be more like

Jesus.

BE CONSIDERATE

When we consider others better than ourselves, we reflect the very nature of Christ. Always consider the people serving alongside you and the kids you are serving. Find opportunities to elevate other people around you and encourage them as much as possible.

PERSONAL PURSUITS

Develop Christ-like character: In order to develop a character like Jesus we must be people who live together in humility, integrity, and excellence.

Connect to the family of

God: Attending church, small groups, praying, serving, inviting, etc. are all expressions of being a part of the church. Weave yourself into the fabric of God and you and the church will be stronger.

OPENING CEREMONY is a time for all the classes to be together. We will hear announcements, practice our monthly memory verse, play a short trivia game with questions from our previous week's lesson, and raise money for missions.

GAME TIME will be a time for the kids to to get their wiggles out and enjoy community!

WORSHIP is a new practice we're implementing in midweek this year. It's incredibly important that we pour into the kid's spiritual lives in this way by getting excited about worshipping the Lord alongside them!

LARGE GROUP is where the kids will be learning about the lesson each week. The curriculum has lessons that cater to both a younger and older audience, so K-2nd will be learning together and 3-5th will be learning together. Besides the age differences, the stories and main ideas are relatively the same. **Since we will be learning as a larger group, teachers will only need to teach every 3 weeks.** For object lessons, the director will provide all materials needed for teaching (please reach out in advance if you are not including all segments of the lesson). Reminder emails will be sent each week to ensure everyone is informed about when they are teaching. If you are aware in advance of missing a week to teach, we ask that you please find someone to fill in for you.

SMALL GROUP is an intentional time for students to ask the leaders questions about the lesson. Guided questions, worksheets, coloring pages, memory verse videos, and announcement flyers will be available at this time. This is also when snack will be provided to kids.
